Appointment to this position requires proof of qualification and or registration with the Pharmacists Board of Queensland with any necessary endorsements.

Employees are to comply with any code or set of standards governing their activities where they are employed in an established profession. Where it is a requirement of their position, employees must maintain relevant registration or licence and provide evidence on an annual basis

Location Information

The Fraser Coast Region of Queensland enjoys a sub-tropical climate, is rich in natural resources, affordable land, high quality water supplies and first class attractions such as World Heritage-listed Fraser Island.

With a population of 76,000 and growing, the region encompasses the rural shires of Woocoo and Tiaro, the historical city of Maryborough and the modern, beachside city of Hervey Bay.

Location

Maryborough is about 255 km north of Brisbane (3 hours drive). Hervey Bay is a further 34 km north-east. The town of Tiaro in the centre of Tiaro Shire is 230 km north of Brisbane and Woocoo Shire surrounds Maryborough to the south, east and west.

Climate

The Fraser Coast enjoys a comfortable, temperate climate. In summer temperatures average between 20 and 30 degrees C. Average temperatures in spring are between 15 and 27 degrees C. In winter temperatures average between 9 and 22 degrees C. Autumn between 14 and 25 degrees C. Average rainfall between December and March is about 160 mm; the remainder of the year averages approximately 55 mm.

The People/Socio Demographics

The Fraser Coast region is home to 76,000 people who enjoy living in an area rich in natural resources, high quality water supplies, low-cost living and affordable house and land prices. Most religious denominations are represented in both major centres and all major service organisations are active, contributing substantially to the Fraser Coast community.

Education Facilities/Family Care

Fraser Coast residents are well catered for. The region has 38 State pre-school, primary and high schools, two facilities for children with special needs, six private schools catering for students from years 1 to 12. Both centres have fully resourced TAFE Colleges and University of Southern Queensland campus at Hervey Bay.

Places of Interest

The Fraser Coast abounds with attractions that are too numerous to list. They include: The region's namesake, Fraser Island, the largest sand island in the world.

From August through to October Hervey Bay plays host to the majestic Humpback whales as they return with their young to the Antarctic for the summer.

Hervey Bay and the Great Sandy Straits, a magnificent waterway running between Fraser Island and the mainland, are a fisherman's paradise with an abundance of marine life and safe sailing. Toogoom and Burrum Heads, north of Hervey Bay, are both popular fishing and camping areas and offer an array of affordable holiday accommodation.

Information for pharmacists outside Queensland or Australia

Pharmacists registered in another Australian state or territory or in New Zealand are eligible for registration to practise in Queensland under mutual recognition. Pharmacists registered in the UK, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland may be eligible for registration as a pharmacist in Queensland, subject to reciprocal agreement requirements, satisfactory completion of four weeks supervised training and a satisfactory assessment interview.
