CLINICAL PRACTICE

- The position will be required to deliver a professional clinical pharmacy service for a rural facility, with increasing complexity as experience develops. The position will utilise evidence based practice, established guidelines, policies and procedures to support clinical decisions in consultation with the multidisciplinary team.
- The level of competence displayed and clinical outcomes achieved will be commensurate with experience gained. As experience builds, pharmacists will be expected to apply increasingly independent clinical judgement to more complex clinical decision making under the clinical practice supervision or professional guidance of a more senior clinician.
- Deliver clinical pharmacy services (which will include dispensing – inpatient, outpatient & discharge, requisition, medication reconciliation, drug information, counselling and recommendation) in accordance with prescribed professional and ethical standards.
- Gather evidence and dev in the development of pharmacy clinical practices, procedures and protocols. To participate in quality and service improvement activities to continually improve patient / client care.

COMMUNICATION / TEAM PARTICPATION

- Develop clinical practice knowledge and expertise through active learning within the team and by engaging in professional development activities.
- Work cooperatively and effectively within the multidisciplinary team and with patients / clients and operationally report to the Director of Nursing (DON).

LEADERSHIP / WORK UNIT MANAGEMENT

- Accountable for managing caseload and workflow utilising innovative mechanisms to achieve a sustainable service including but is not limited to managing resources, stock levels and equipment ordering to allow provision of a high quality Pharmacy service across the continuum.
- Participate in the identification, development and implementation of quality and service improvement activities that enhance the delivery pf pharmacy services within the Proserpine Hospital.
- Provide clinical practice, education and operational supervision to less experienced staff, work experience students, or those involved in observational clinical placements.
- This position will undertake tasks and caseloads as directed by the DON and communicate all clinical and workload concerns as appropriate.

Information for pharmacists outside Queensland or Australia

Pharmacists registered in another Australian state or territory or in New Zealand are eligible for registration to practise in Queensland under mutual recognition. Pharmacists registered in the UK, Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland may be eligible for registration as a pharmacist in Queensland, subject to reciprocal agreement requirements, satisfactory completion of four weeks supervised training and a satisfactory assessment interview. Contact the Pharmacists Board of Queensland to enquire about your eligibility (details below).

Pharmacists registered in countries other than Australia, UK, Northern Ireland, the Republic of Ireland and New Zealand should contact APEC (details below) about obtaining registration in Australia.
