

SHPA Website Security Statement

The SHPA website (www.shpa.org.au) is operated by The Society of Hospital Pharmacists of Australia (ABN 54 004 553 806).

SHPA website uses a Secure Sockets Layer (SSL) which uses a 128 bit SSL encryption to protect the loss or misuse of information under the control of SHPA.

You can tell if a website is secured via an SSL Certificate by looking for the padlock icon. If a secure session is established between a browser and a web server the "http:" will change to "https:". It is possible to tell the strength of the encryption by moving the mouse over the padlock, in Internet Explorer the strength e.g. 128 will be displayed, in Netscape double click over the padlock to view the certificate – the encryption strength is shown on the first tab of the certificate.

Although SHPA has chosen up-to-date high level security features SHPA cannot warrant the security of information that you transfer to SHPA.
