

Specialty Practice CPD Guide

Gain CPD points and broaden your expertise by engaging in Specialty Practice forums.

Interactions or activity count towards annual CPD credits if they:

- Improve your practice as a pharmacist
- Provide you with information you can use in your practice
- Prepare you for new/future roles in pharmacy
- Address the CPD needs outlined in your CPD plan.

Group 1, 2 or 3 CPD?

Group 1

- Provides new knowledge or confirms existing knowledge, or
- Prompts further exploration of the topic to expand understanding or knowledge.

Group 2

- Prompts reflection on new knowledge: 'What does it mean for my practice? What do I need to do next?'
- Keep records of your reflections to count as Group-2 credits

Group 3

- Prompts change in practice in response to knowledge acquired, or
- Decision not to change practice because knowledge confirmed change was unwarranted

Keeping a record of your participation in Specialty Practice forums is easy:

- Opt to receive an email of any post to a forum you are enrolled in
- Use emails as the basis for reflection on your practice
- Keep emails as a record informing your practice and professional development
